Registration Rules for IBSU Arranged Exam

An applicant should address The Faculty of Social Sciences, Humanities and Education (Room #302) to fill in IBSU application form (R17F02) for registering to IBSU arranged exam and submit the following documentation:

- Copy of a notary verified B.A., M.A. or/and identical academic degree certificate;
- In case of foreign diploma, applicants should provide their notary verified translated copies approved by the National Center of Education Quality Enhancement;
- ID copy;
- 2 photos (3X4);
- CD format photo;
- CV (Georgian and English);
- Military record (for male applicants);
- Examination score document;
- Applicants are obliged to pass IBSU exam which are in compliance with their academic degree in a subject/group of subjects and subject exam the have passed;
- Exams are arranged by the faculty.

IBSU Arranged Examination Rules

- IBSU arranged examination is conducted in a written form, in English and maximum point is 20.
- Examination time is 90 minutes. Applicants should write a 500 word motivation essay and state his/her motivation for a program, substantiate the need for his/her professional development and define the means of achievement of those goals.
- Essay is evaluated by maximum 20 points. Evaluation criteria are given in R17F02.
- Exam papers are checked by at least three corresponding field(s) experts holding doctoral degree.
- Applicants will receive exam results via e-mail at least in one working day after the results are announced.
